Mayor's Youth Council Meeting

Mayor's Minute: Mayor Andersen talked about the importance of a formal MYAC meeting and how to approve a consent agenda using Robert's Rules of Order. He then expressed celebrating the differences among the group using a bag of M&M(s) and encouraged everyone to give and be open to different people and ideas.

Consent Agenda: President Stolworthy distributed the minutes from the last meeting for review, and reported a current finance report was not included. President Stolworthy entertained a motion. Member Isabelle Estrada made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Member Stolworthy seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion was approved.

Items of Business:

- A. *Appointment of Advisor:* Mayor Andersen discussed the need of another advisor to help out when he and Advisor Roberts are unavailable and attending other meetings throughout the week. He would like to appoint Member Isabelle Estrada as a MYAC Advisor. President Stolworthy entertained a motion. Social Media Specialist Roberts moved to approve Isabelle Estrada as a MYAC Advisor. Secretary Rigby seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion was approved.
- B. *Iona's Annual Trunk or Treat:* Mayor Andersen reported this year's Trunk or Treat will be held on Tuesday, October 31st at 6:00 pm. Members should plan on being here for the Trunk or Treat from 5:00 – 7:00 pm. Members discussed hosting a cake walk fundraiser during Iona's Annual Trunk or Treat. Mayor Andersen suggested it should be a free since the Trunk or Treat is a free event to the public. President Stolworthy agreed it should be a service event. The MYAC banner will be set up with table and two cars decorated. Social Media Specialist suggested having a free game for the kids to play. President Stolworthy suggested a lot more decorations to make the cars noticeable. Mayor Andersen suggested the group split up and students from Hillcrest High School decorate

one vehicle and the students from Bonneville High School decorate the other. Member Stolworthy volunteered to lead the Bonneville vehicle decorating. Advisor Estrada volunteered to lead the Hillcrest vehicle decorating. Service Coordinator Sewell will be the main person in charge of organizing both groups.

- C. Ideas for the Upcoming Year: Social Media Specialist Roberts brought up participating in the City of Ammon's 2nd Annual Pumpkin Walk beginning on October 21st and ending on October 31st. If the group puts time and effort into the display they could potentially win a prize ranging from \$50 - \$200. A few themes were suggested, but nothing decided upon. After further discussion, the group decided they would like to participate and will schedule a date to put together the display and a theme before then.
- D. T-Shirts Mayor Andersen explained the group as a whole can order new t-shirts this year, or they can save money from their budget and just put an order in for the new members who have joined this year. After further discussion, the group decided they would prefer to just order shirts for new members. Clerk Roberts handed out extra shirts leftover from last year to the new members, and took down needed sizes for those that didn't get one. She will put the order in this week.
