"Walking/Biking Path" – The City is proud to announce that we have been awarded a Child Pedestrian Grant in the amount of \$125,500 to help install a walking/biking path on the south side of Iona Elementary School. The paved path will be located on Denning Avenue from Ashwood Lane, going all the way to Barnes Avenue. We are thrilled to have this addition in our community and are hopeful this will increase safety and accessibility for school-aged children, and all residents of Iona. Construction will begin in late spring/early summer of this year. More information on the construction schedule will be released, as it gets closer.


