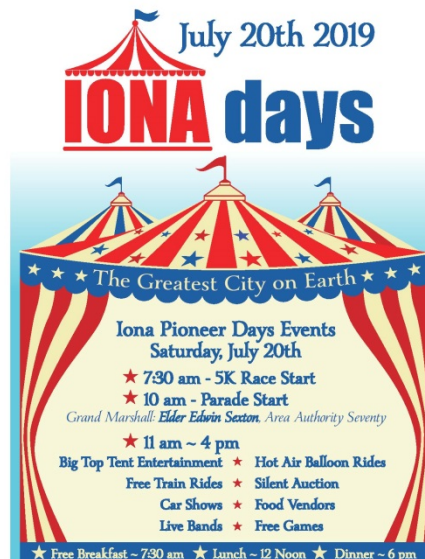
Iona Days

WATER SERVICE RATE INCREASE

At the City Council Meeting held Tuesday, May 21, 2019, the City Council of the City of Iona implemented an increase to the Monthly Water Service Rate, as previously approved by the voters in the City of Iona as part of the Bond Election in November 2017 to build a new water tank. The new monthly water service rate is \$49.00 and will begin with the June water billing. The City of Iona's Planning & Zoning Commission has scheduled the following Public Hearings on the evening of June 12, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at the Iona City Building, which is located at 3548 N. Main St, Iona, ID. Subsequent Public Hearings will be held by the City Council for final approval on June 25, 2019 at 7:15 p.m.

“Conditional Use Permit” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider a Conditional Use Permit for Peter Wadsworth to allow an in-home case management business.

“Re-Zone Application” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider a Re-Zone Application for Jeff Blackburn to change the current zoning from C-1 to R-1 for

Parcel# RPC3180002005B located on Main Street.

“Amended Plat Application” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider an Amended Plat Application for H&H Property Investments to re-plat the parcel located at 5036 E. Walker Avenue to three (3) lots, each over .335 acres.

“Water Conservation” - As in past years, we are asking people whose address ends with an odd number (e.g. 245) to water on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Those with an address that ends with an even number (e.g. 356) to water on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. On Sunday, please limit your watering to the bare minimum. By doing this, it will help the City to conserve water, keep costs down, maintain better water pressure for you as a customer, and a healthier lawn. It is better for your lawn to water every 2-3 days, than to water every day.
