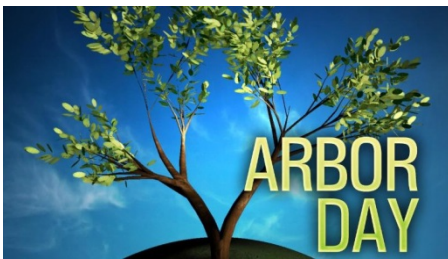

Important Information



The City of Iona’s Planning & Zoning Commission has scheduled the following Public Hearing on the evening of May 8, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at the Iona City Building, which is located at 3548 N. Main St, Iona, ID. A subsequent Public Hearing will be held by the City Council for final approval on May 21, 2019 at 7:15 p.m.

“Conditional Use Permit” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider a Conditional Use Permit for Alice Bodily Olsen to allow a basement rental at 3180 N. Olsen Street.

“Re-Zone Application” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider a Re-Zone Application for Kirt Schwieder to change the current zoning from R-1 to R-A for his property at 4949 E. Iona Road and the parcel directly to the east.

The City of Iona’s City Council has scheduled the following Public Hearings on May 21, 2019 at 7:25 p.m. at the Iona City Building, which is located at 3548 N. Main St, Iona, ID.

“Repeal and Replace Iona City Code 11-10-1: Filing Fees” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider an increase in zoning application fees to better align with administrative requirements and expenses.

“Repeal and Replace Iona City Code 8-2: Water Service” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider updates to the Water Service Chapter of the Iona City Code, including implementation of an Equivalent Dwelling Unit Classification, all of which will have the effect of increasing water service fees in excess of 5%, as previously approved by the voters in the City of Iona.

“City Office Closed” – The City Office will be closed on Monday, May 27th in observance of Memorial Day. We will re-open on Tuesday, May 28th at 9:00 a.m.

Police Department

“Parking on City Streets” – Chief Bowcutt would like to remind all residents that trailers and vehicles are not permitted to be parked on public right-of-ways for longer than 24 hours. Any vehicle in violation is subject to citations and towing.

Public Works

“Water Conservation” - As in past years, we are asking people whose address ends with an odd number (e.g. 245) to water on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Those with an address that ends with an even number (e.g. 356) to water on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. On Sunday, please limit your watering to the bare minimum. By doing this, it will help the City to conserve water, keep costs down, better water pressure for you as a customer, and a healthier lawn. It is better for your lawn to water every 2-3 days, than to water every day.
