"2019 City Elections" – The 2019 Election will take place on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. The City of Iona will have two (2) open City Council seats. Candidate filing began on Monday, August 26, 2019 and will close on Friday, September 6, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. A candidate must submit a Declaration of Candidacy specifying the office and term for which they are running. The candidate must also affirm they meet the legal requirements to run. A Declaration of Candidacy must be accompanied by one of the following: (1) A Petition of Candidacy signed by at least 5 qualified city electors, or (2) a nonrefundable filing fee of \$40. If you have any other questions, please call Bonneville County Elections at 208-529-1350 or the City Clerk at 208-523-5600.

"Bike Paths" – The City has completed the new bike path on Denning Avenue, adding to the existing bike paths on Iona Road and Main Street. Please remember, it is NOT permissible to drive or park vehicles on any bike path or the rocks next to it. **Iona City Code § 9-6-4 states, "Any person who operates a motor vehicle or parks a vehicle upon or across any bicycle path, except at intersections of a path within a public street or alley or when necessary to enter or leave a driveway, is guilty of an infraction."** Bonneville County Sheriff's Office will be enforcing this to allow greater safety for anyone utilizing these bike paths on foot or bike.

The City of Iona’s Planning & Zoning Commission has scheduled the following Public Hearing on the evening of September 11, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at the Iona City Building, which is located at 3548 N. Main St, Iona, ID. A subsequent Public Hearing will be held by the City Council for final approval on September 24, 2019 at 7:15 p.m.

“Conditional Use Permit Application” – A Public Hearing will be held to consider a Conditional Use Permit Application, for Mr. Ken Baldwin to operate a wholesale automobile sales business from his home.

“City Budget” – The budget of \$5,939,821 for Fiscal Year 2020 was approved and passed by Ordinance at the City Council Meeting held Tuesday, August 20th, 2019.

“Water Conservation” – As in past years, we are asking residents whose address ends with an odd number (ex. 245) to
