“Sheds and Shops”- Looking to add a Shed or Shop to your property? Here’s the process! If your shed or shop will be over 200 square feet, you will need to submit your plot plans, building plans and application to the City Office and our inspector will look over it to figure out how many inspections will need to take place. This will determine the fee that you will pay. If further information is needed the city will contact you. Once everything is submitted and your fee is paid your work can begin! “Fence Permit Required” – In order to insure the safety and correct location of new fences, a permit will now be required to install a fence on a property line. This requires a \$50 permit fee for the City to process the application and verify the correct placement of the fence.
