
Team Softball/ T-ball/ Machine Pitch

Public Hearing

On Tuesday, March 26th at 7:05pm, the Iona City Council will hold a Public Hearing for a Variance Application for AHG Capital LLC, for the proposed Wolf Meadows Subdivision, located on Parcel# RPO200001002B within the area of impact, on the North side of 49th North, in between Ammon Road and 45th East. The Variance requested is to reduce the minimum side setback requirement from 10 feet to 8 feet for the R-1.5 Zone, per the Bonneville County Area of Impact Agreement.

Winter Parking Restrictions

Per Iona City Code § 9-4-5(C), "It shall be unlawful to park or place any vehicle upon any road way as defined above, from and including the period commencing on November 22nd to and until April 10th of the following year, between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday November 22nd until April 10th of the following year, between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Reflective Driveway Markers

All reflective driveway markers placed by homeowners need to be removed no later than March 10, 2024, after this date the city public works department will be removing the remaining markers.

Construction Announcement

Big News! The City of Iona has been awarded a grant from the Idaho Transportation Department. The City will soon be using these funds to rebuild the roads of Free, Scoresby and Denning Avenues to include curb, gutter and sidewalks. The project will be going out to bid in mid-March with construction taking place in 2024. The City will provide updates as the project progresses and as dates are finalized.
