



**The City of Iona is retaining a Contractor to provide the following services (the “Services”):**

Snow removal services on City rights-of-way and/or City property, utilizing the City equipment specified on Exhibit B hereto that the Contractor is qualified and able to use. Such snow removal shall begin within one (1) hour of being notified of a Snow Event (typically the accumulation of two or more inches of snow) requiring such Service, which notice will be sent by the City’s Public Works Director by text message, phone call, or other means arranged by Contractor and the City’s Public Works Director. Each provision of the Services will cease when the City’s Public Works Director, or the guidance provided by the City’s Public Works Director, directs that enough snow has been removed and/or cleared to sufficiently mitigate the effects of that particular Snow Event.

Contractor may be required to regularly lift up to 50 pounds in the course of providing the Services, and is required to maintain a valid Idaho driver’s license. In the provision of these Services, the Contractor is required to be able to see and hear, as well as speak English. Note that multiple snow events may occur in a single day, to each of which Contractor agrees to respond in accordance herewith. While most notice will be given to the Contractor the day prior to any Services, the one-hour response time is important and may be necessary in certain situations.

**Contractor shall provide the above-described Services during the following term:**

From the Effective Date hereof until 11:59 p.m. (Mountain Time) on April 30, 2025.

**The City shall provide the following items, equipment, and/or information to the Contractor:**

Snow shovel(s), snow blower, UTV with a front snowplow, and/or a backhoe with a 12-foot-wide snow removal box attachment.

**The City’s Public Works Director will provide the information and decision to the Contractor regarding when a Snow Event occurs and when the Services are required.**
