

## Public Works

### Construction Projects

Starting in April, the approved construction project to update Scoresby Ave. will take place between the corner of Olsen Ave. and Scoresby Ave. through to Dayton Street and Scoresby Ave. Those residents who will be directly affected by the construction have been notified.

### Reflective Driveway Markers

All reflective driveway markers placed by homeowners need to be removed no later than March 10, 2026, after this date the city public works department will be removing any remaining markers.

### Ditches

A reminder to residents who have a ditch through their property: they are responsible for clearing the ditch of any obstructions in the section that runs through their property. All residents should be aware that it is unlawful to dispose in, or obstruct any ditch. For more information please review the Code Book, Title 5, Chapter 6.
