Water Conservation

In order to continue to provide efficient water service and water pressure to our customers, it is necessary to implement a restriction for outside watering of lawns and landscaping. Outside water use will be limited as follows: if your address ends with an odd number (ex. 245) you are allowed to water on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Those with an address that ends with an even number (ex. 356) should water on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. On Sunday, please limit your watering to the bare minimum. We are getting into the hot and dry months. It will help the City to conserve water, keep costs down, and provide better water pressure to every resident. Thank you!

Scoresby Avenue

In order to provide safe, reliable drinking water to every household in our community, The City of Iona will be updating water service lines along Scoresby Avenue. Construction will begin March 31st and conclude in approximately 4-6 weeks. These improvements are in compliance with federal and state drinking water regulations.

Scoresby Avenue Boil Advisory

A Boil Advisory has been issued for the residents of Scoresby Avenue from Olsen Street to Dayton Street. The City of Iona water distribution system will be losing pressure below 20 PSI due to a planned water repair/replacement project. Those residents who will be affected have been notified by our Public Works Department as of March 30th. Please refer to the distributed letter for further instructions and information.
